

Rural Municipality of Arlington No. 79
BYLAW NO. 306

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTING VEHICLES
ON CERTAIN MUNICIPAL ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Arlington, No. 79, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows pursuant to the authority of Section 35(1) of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* and Sections 188, 189, and 206(2)(f) of *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989*:

PART I – PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

- 1 The purpose of this bylaw is to establish a vehicle weight management system to regulate the weight of vehicles, or vehicles with their loads, using the oil surface route within the Municipality commonly known as the oil surface portion of Grid 633 located East of 13, 24, & SE 25-7-21-3; Thru 25, 36, & 35-7-21-3; and through SW 2-8-21-3.

Definitions

2. In this bylaw: “Administrator” means the Administrator of the Municipality, appointed pursuant to Section 49 of *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989*.

PART II – VEHICLE WEIGHTS

Weight Limits on Certain Roads

3. (A) No person shall, without a permit issued pursuant to Section 4 of this bylaw operate or move or cause to be operated or moved on or over the oil surface road, a vehicle with their load in excess of 10,000 Kilograms (22,000 pounds.) The Maximum gross weight on any axle not to exceed 6000 Kilograms (13,200 pounds).
- (B) This restriction applies to all vehicles except those listed below:
 - (i) Emergency Vehicles
 - (ii) All utility vehicles – (including but not limited to Sask Power, Sask Tel and Trans Gas) when accessing sites on or along the restricted roads.
 - (iii) School Buses
 - (iv) Municipal Equipment or Contracted Equipment.


Permits

4. (A) Notwithstanding section 3 of this bylaw, the Administrator may, if satisfied that the vehicle or combination of vehicles can be operated or moved upon the oil surface road without damage to the oil surface road or other property, issue a permit to the registered owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles to exceed the maximum gross vehicle weights fixed by this bylaw.
- (B) For an annual permit, the permit shall be carried in the vehicle and be produced upon request by a peace officer or the Administrator or his or her designate.
- (C) For a single trip permit, the permit number must be provided upon request by a peace officer or the Administrator or his or her designate.
- (D) The permit shall allow the holder the right of access on this oil surface road for the shortest distance required for access to another municipal road.
- (E) Annual and single trip permit fees shall be set by resolution of Council.
- (F) This permit does not allow the holder to exceed the Saskatchewan Vehicle Weights and Dimensions regulations as per *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 1999* Sections 7 and 8.

PART III – ENFORCEMENT

Penalty

5. (A) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offense.
- (B) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.




