Whereas:

- Rural communities near the US border are heavily dependant on trade and tourism from the United States to sustain their local economies
- A reduction in border services would force many Canadians in rural communities to drive hours out of the way to access essential goods and services across the border
- The Canadian Border Service Agency has done no consultation with affected communities or stakeholders about the impacts of reducing border services.
- A functional border is our first line of defence against drugs, weapons, and human trafficking.

We, the undersigned, citizens and residents of Canada, call upon the Government of Canada to pause any plans by CBSA to reduce border services and:

- 1. Consult with relevant stakeholders regarding the impacts of border closures;
- 2. Commit to providing adequate border services to rural communities across Canada
