MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN RURAL MUNICIPALITIES

- ➤ Election day is November 13, 2024. This is held for the Reeve and Councillors for Division 1, 3 and 5.
- > The term of office for all members is four years.
- ➤ The nomination period is September 17th until October 8th, 2024. The office hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. until Nomination Day, which is October 9th, 2024 until 4:00 p.m. Nominations will not be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on day of October 9th, 2024.

WHO CAN BE NOMINATED?

- 1. At least 18 years old on election day;
- 2. A Canadian citizen;
- 3. Eligible to vote in the rural municipality*; and
- 4. A resident of Saskatchewan.

*Eligible to Vote:

- Be at least 18 years old;
- 2. Be a Canadian citizen; and
- 3. Must qualify as one of the following:
 - a. a resident in the rural municipality for at least three consecutive month immediately preceding the day of the election;
 - b. the registered owner (or purchaser under a bona fide agreement for sale) of land in the rural municipality;

- c. assessed with respect to land in the rural municipality under a lease, license, permit, or contract in agreement with the registered owner, (Section 207 of the Act, must be on the assessment role);
- d. assessed with respect to an improvement in the rural municipality;
- e. hold a permit in the rural municipality with respect to a trailer or mobile home;
- f. a spouse of a person mentioned in clause (b), (c), (d), or (e); or
- g. the chief executive officer of a duly incorporated co-operative, corporation or religious association that is assessed on the last revised assessment roll with respect to property in the rural municipality that is not exempted from taxation.
